It is hard to understand the impact a burn has on a person regardless of the injury. Previous patients tell us that it can be really valuable to meet others with similar experiences of burns and relatives can benefit from the contact too. The group meet three times a year. The meetings usually consist of an activity (previous activities have been chocolate making, jewellery making to name a few) with lunch and drinks. The meetings are informal with options of gaining information on scar management, diet, psychological help or just a chat and a sharing of experiences. The group is open to any adult over the age of 16 who have experienced a burn, or is a relative of someone who has experienced a burn of any type and any size at any age and have been treated at any hospital. If bringing your family and friends means that you would feel more comfortable coming along then they are very welcome. This group offers a unique opportunity to not only get support from but also to give support to other burns survivors
