# What is a community diagnostic centre?

 Community Diagnostic Centres (CDCs) provide a broad range of elective diagnostics away from acute facilities, reducing pressure on hospitals and giving patients quicker and more convenient access to tests.

 CDCs co-ordinate all the diagnostic tests a patient requires and, wherever possible, provide them under one roof in a single visit.
